Send all records and files pursuant to criminal evidenced submitted to any and all officials by investigating FBI agents Cecilia A. Kong and also Michael Carmona in Hawaii regarding suspect Paul J. Sulla, Jr. and all allegations and evidence of Sulla having forged documents for real property theft, securities fraud, money laundering, and drug trafficking from the Big Island of Hawaii to the mainland U.S. of the Class I narcotic hallucinogen dimethyltryptamine ("DMT"). Include any and all records on file pursuant to the Complainant, Leonard George Horowitz.

Expedite

Expedite Reason

- 1) Suspect is alleged drug kingpin running a large racketeering enterprise with substantial evidence of public corruption, thus lack of expedited treatment could reasonably be expected to pose a threat to the Complainant's safety;
- 2) Complainant/victim/witness is suffering the loss of substantial due process rights, having had justice obstructed by officials' neglected duties for several years, defying two previously affirming FBI agents' reports to administer indictments. FBI has thus aided-and-abetted by willful blindness the alleged racketeering enterprise and damages to the public and Complainant.
- 3) The Complainant is an internationally known award-winning journalist and filmmaker professionally and p"rimarily engaged in disseminating information to the public and the information is urgently needed to inform the public concerning some actual or alleged federal government activity;" and negligence regarding public health risk from drug trafficking risk to society; and
- 4) "[T]he subject of the request is of widespread and exceptional media interest and the information sought involves possible questions about the government's integrity which affect public confidence. Decisions to expedite under this fourth standard are made by DOJ's Director of Public Affairs."
